MANUFACTURING ACCELERATOR PROGRAM (MAP)

Insyte Consulting is excited to announce it is partnering with NYSEG to secure access to reimbursable grant funding for the utility customers served by NYSEG. These grants are not tied to energy usage, and are intended to support a diverse range of operational improvement and growth related projects that improve productivity and increase revenues!

INSYTE will do the work related to writing the grant application on your company's behalf, and submitting it for approval, once the company signs the Insyte proposal.

- Matching reimbursable grants up to the lesser of **\$15,000, or 40%**, of the costs incurred by eligible applicants whose top management commits the time and resources to productivity improvement projects such as Lean manufacturing, Lean office procedures, waste reduction, ISO quality programs and other projects that lower costs, improve quality and reduce lead times.
- Matching reimbursable grants up to the lesser of **\$15,000, or 50%**, to fund growth-targeted activities such as new product development, export initiatives, sales and marketing system improvements, and other projects designed to increase revenue.
- Applicants who choose to commit time and resources to both productivity and growth initiatives will be eligible for a reimbursable grant of up to **\$40,000, or 60%** (whichever is less), of the costs incurred to implement such transformative programs.

It is important to note that in order to receive consideration for the grant program, the grant recipient must be the owner or leaseholder of the facility receiving utility services and must be current in payments to NYSEG or have a deferred payment agreement in place and be current in payment to that agreement.
